**ORPHEUS Mundus**

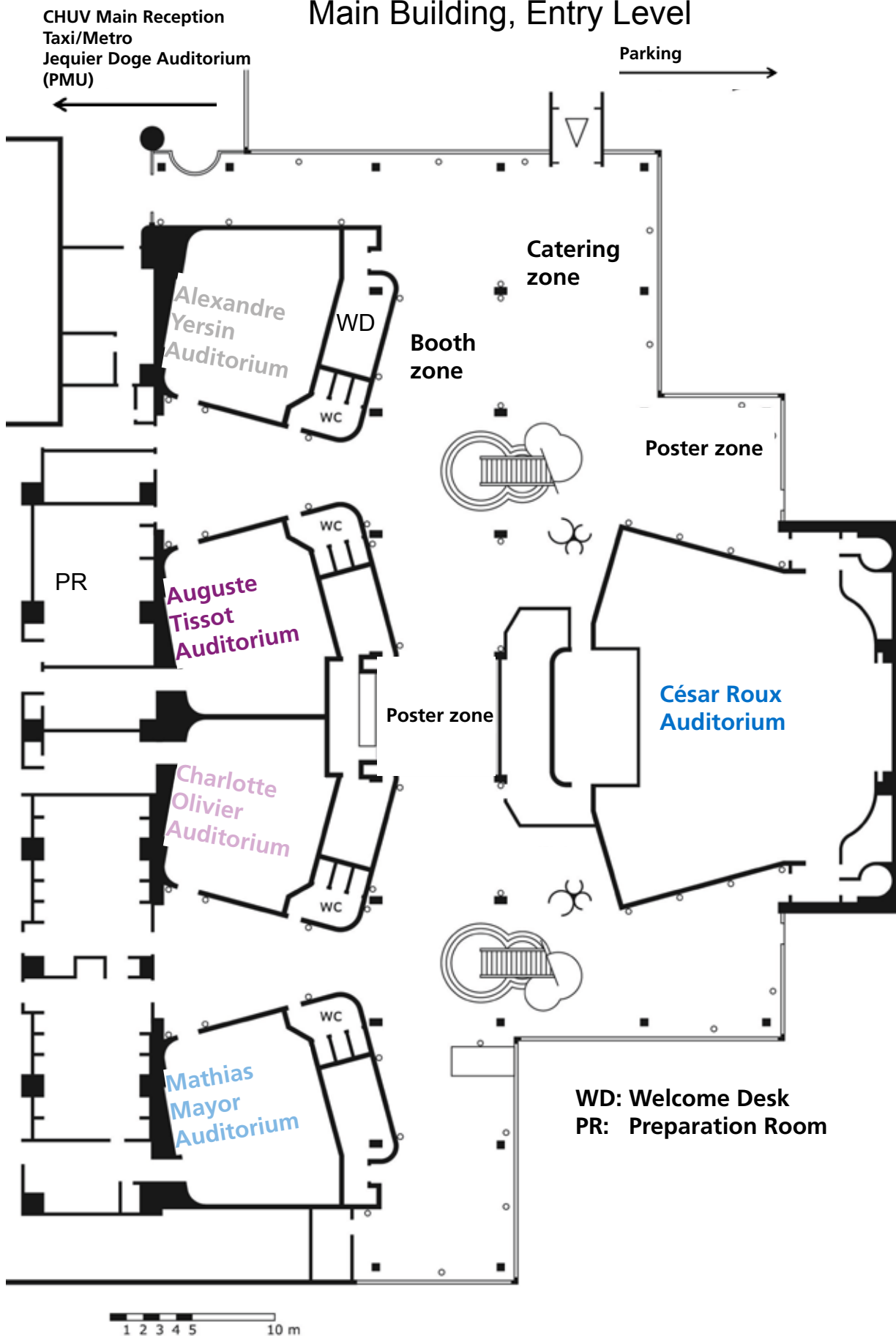
## PhD Candidates' Night
